The programmes were held from Oct 12 2017 to May 30 2018, with 8 sessions for each group in each term. The focus was on how to improve writing in the areas of language (i.e. grammar & sentence patterns). The attendance was 91.4% which was quite satisfactory.

They needed to attempt challenging mathematics problems. They were then nominated for various Math competitions. The overall attendance rates of S4 and S4 were 82% and 74% respectively.

Same as above	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Four programmes including comic and marker illustration course, logo design course, painting course and animation course were organized for S4 to S5 VAD students in 2017-18. • 13 sessions of the comic and marker illustration course were conducted from October 2017 to May 2018. 100% of the participants achieved 80% or above attendance rate in the comic and marker illustration course. The VAD students were taught to draw different human body gesture and facial expression by drawing markers. • 4 sessions of the logo design course were conducted from May to June 2018. 70% of the participants achieved 100% attendance rate in the logo design course while 30% participants achieved 75%. 10 logo designs for the 55th anniversary of our school were created with our VAD students’ unique ideas. 1 of the logo design won the logo design competition and it becomes the 55th SFXS anniversary logo. • 2 sessions of the painting course were conducted in August 2018. 100% of the participants achieved 100% attendance rate in the painting course. Various painting skills were introduced to enable students to effectively present their themes. Paintings with diverse themes and of considerable level of performance were produced. • 13 sessions of animation course were organized for the S5 VAD students in July and August 2017. The computer graphic and animation skills were taught in the first 6 sessions, while 7 sessions of individual tutorials were organized to enable students to refine their artwork. 80% of the participants achieved 80% or above

				<p>attendance rate in the painting course. However, one student was not able to participate in the course frequently as he had to practise his Chinese opera performance in August. Animations of diverse themes were produced with considerable quality.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The students' feedback towards the enrichment courses was positive. According to the students' questionnaires, the participants (90% or above) of all the comic and marker illustration class, painting class, logo class and animation class agreed that the courses could enrich their abilities in art making. 90% participants believed the comic and marker illustration class, painting class and animation class could enhance their abilities in art appreciation, as well as their interests of art making.

NSS – Other Programme 7	30 S6 students were selected for a 3-session course in October to December. The students' feedback towards the EDBIT LIMITED course was positive. According to the students' questionnaires, the participants (100%) of the class believed the course can help to enhance their LS. 100% of the S6 students were satisfied with the course content and the instructor.
